1. Establish an internship program designed to help members of the community acquire skills needed for broadcast employment.

Date: Ongoing

The Employment Unit has an ongoing internship program, which is advertised on our websites and at career fairs that the Employment Unit attends, which are sponsored by local colleges.

Internships are offered in the Promotions, Sales, News and Production departments. Interns generally work at the Employment Unit for one semester for college credit. Approximately nine interns worked with the stations during the reporting period.

During the reporting period, the following colleges have had or currently have interns at one of the stations in the Employment Unit: The Connecticut School of Broadcasting, William Paterson University, Roanoke College, Clemson University, Rutgers University, Muhlenburg College, Davidson University, Montclair State University, and Seton Hall University.

2. Establish training programs designed to enable station personnel to acquire skills that could qualify them for higher level positions.

Public File Seminar

Date: 3/4/09

A Public Information Training Seminar was held in the Somerset Office for employees in the New Jersey Radio Group. Two educational sessions concerning a critical compliance issue in broadcasting (*i.e.*, proper compliance with the public file requirement) were presented by Dale Gehman of Gehman Compliance and Consulting.
